Certification

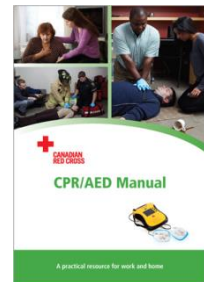
3-year certification in CPR Level A, C, or HCP and AED

Recertification

Where provincial/territorial legislation allows; 4 hours; includes CPR Level C
