Certification

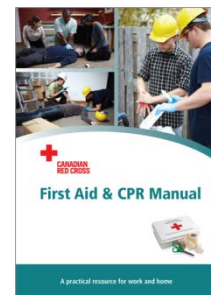
3-year certification in Emergency First Aid, CPR Level A, C, or HCP and AED
